

ADOPT-A-SPOT PROGRAM



Spring is finally here so it's time to start planning for your 2021 Adopt-A-Spot area!

The City of Belding requests volunteers to maintain the landscaping areas surrounding the mall. Annually, the Downtown Development Authority (DDA) authorizes the purchase of landscaping mulch from Nature's Needs Landscape Design and Construction. Participants will receive, at their convenience, mulch free of charge for each spot they have adopted. Spots are numbered and participants may have their name placed on a sign that is installed by the City at their respective spot(s).

Participants are encouraged to prepare their spot(s) by Memorial Day (May 31), and maintain them throughout the season. Maintenance reminders will be sent to ensure beds are groomed for Gus Macker weekend (July 31 and August 1) and Labor Day weekend (September 3, 4, 5 & 6).

Upon request, participants may obtain biodegradable yard waste bags from City Hall for clean-up.
