NOTE: The passage of the City of Belding Charter Amendment No. 1 on the November 8, 2016 General Election states as follows: “Each member of a City Board or Commission shall have been a resident of the City for at least one year immediately prior to the day of his/her appointment and shall be a qualified and registered elector of the City on such day and through his/her tenure in office except that a minority of the members on the Library Board, Museum Board and Recreation Advisory Board may be non-residents of the City.” Applicants interested in consideration for appointment to the Belding Housing Commission or the Library Board must contact those entities directly.
