

### **City Council Meeting:**

- ❖ The property at 110 East Liberty was approved for rezoning from OS-1 (office) back to its original R-2 (single family).
- ❖ Bruce Feuerstein presented a summary of the Museum Activities in 2019. Bruce used the word “gem” in describing our museum, specifically the kids area of the museum. We are honored and lucky to have a museum of this quality in our city. City Council also would like to thank all of the volunteers for their time and commitment in making this a world-class museum and keeping a record of our history.
